ABOUT THE SACRED PORTAL OF AUSTRALIA


Embark with us on a journey to explore one of the world's oldest cultures: the Aboriginals and the sacred land of Oceania, offering inspiration through its landscapes, history, art, and ancestral wisdom. Join me for a 13-day Expedition across various regions of the country, immersing ourselves in the culture through local activities, road trips, meditative activations, and in-depth studies of Australia's Portals.

Discover how we can continue and preserve this knowledge in our lives, integrating it for future generations. It's an opportunity to connect, learn, and preserve the rich heritage of the Australian land.

The Expedition takes place in different Sacred Portals of the planet where we combine the cultural experience with Emana Institute certifications/training and activation meditations in the sacred sites of the region with Marcia Bellö.









(4) Finally, we conclude with the activation of the 12 Apostles,

situated on one of the planet's Kundalini points, in Melbourne.



From an energetic perspective, Australia is viewed as a Portal interconnected with Mount Logan in Canada, contributing to the balance of the planet's feminine and masculine frequencies through the study of Nodes and Nulls. Additionally, woven into its history is the anchoring of Lemurian wisdom – a civilization that predominantly inhabited the Pacific region thousands of years ago. In numerous portals across the country and within Aboriginal studies, Australia establishes connections with the Pleiadian constellation, holding secret keys to the mysteries of Lemuria.

- DAY 02 | Saturday, 15 June 2024
 - 7am Morning Cacao with Meditation and preparation for the day
 - From 9 am Aboriginal Experience and Welcome to Country Ceremony: let's explore a guided journey 'on country' in Australia, delving into the history of colonization and its impact on the indigenous culture. Engage in a traditional Welcome to Country ceremony, connecting spiritually to the land.
 - We are going to embark on a unique journey to explore the ancient culture of the Bundjalung nation, guided by a local Australian Aboriginal host and we are going to explore Sydney's scenic green spaces with rich Aboriginal history and native flora. Our Aboriginal guide will share insights into the world's oldest living culture, providing an opportunity to deepen your connection to the land and embrace the principles of 'caring for country.'
 - Morning tea featuring both traditional and contemporary recipes with native ingredients. Concluding the experience with a special memento from our Aboriginal guide.
 - Lunch from midday: local indigenous-inspired café in a cool local neighbourhood where indigenous families live today.
 - Afternoon & Evening: we are going to visit some of the famous beaches in Sydney and relax evening free and Gathering night

From 14 to 26 of June 2024

DAY 03 | Sunday, 16 June 2024

- 7 am Morning Cacao with Meditation and preparation for the day
- From 9am National Parks and Sacred Portals Activation: we are going to visit one of the oldest National Parks and a unique place to see while in Sydney. Easy Hike (bring shoes) Aboriginal Heritage walk (2km return).
- Aboriginal Heritage Walk, intertwining Resolute and West Head tracks, unveiling historic rock engravings and art from the Guringai people, the land's traditional owners. We are going to explore the Red Hands Cave, renowned for ancient Aboriginal art, and encounter impressive rock engravings along the trail.
- In the afternoon, venture north to the Gosford Glyphs to activate one of the Sacred Aboriginal Portals on the Central Coast of Sydney (Parallel 33 and Pleiadean Energy).
- Returning to Sydney and concluding the day with a hotel drop-off.
- Evening free.

DAY 04 | Monday, 17 June 2024

- Darwin, situated in Gulumerrdgen positioned on a peninsula surrounded by the sea, it serves as an ideal hub for exploring natural wonders like Kakadu National Park, Litchfield and Nitmiluk National Parks, Tiwi Islands, and Arnhem Land. Enriched by a diverse history, Darwin boasts a population of over 50 nationalities, including the Larrakia Aboriginal people.
- Afternoon and Evening Free
- 40 min Gathering Night with Marcia Bellö and the group to anchor the second Portal of the Expedition



From 14 to 26 of June 2024

- DAY 05 | Tuesday, 18 June 2024
 - 7am Morning Cacao with Meditation and preparation for the day
 - From 9am Northern Territory Indigenous Tour
 - Includes: Hotel pick up and drop off, lunch.
 - 9-hour journey to Litchfield National Park, guided by a knowledgeable Indigenous guide with deep ancestral ties to the region. Let's Immerse our group in the rich history spanning countless generations, witnessing firsthand the demonstration of bush resources in season.
 - We are going to explore iconic waterfalls, rejuvenate in their refreshing waters, and witness the
 vibrant life of tropical stone country during the summer. Benefit from expert natural and cultural
 insights from guides with unparalleled knowledge.
 - · The tour concludes with a return to Darwin, where we will be transferred to our accommodation.
 - · Evening free.
- DAY 06 | Wednesday, 19 June 2024
 - 7am Morning Cacao with Meditation and preparation for the day
 - From 9am Full Day Wetland Experience
 - Hotel pickup and dropoff, 2.5 hour wetland cruise, Lunch, Fogg Dam Reserve
 - An insightful 8-hour tour from Darwin to Fogg Dam Nature Reserve.
 - After a morning tea break, proceed to an extraordinary 2.5-hour wetlands cruise, offering close encounters with diverse wildlife.
 - The tour concludes with a transfer back to Darwin to our accommodation.
 - Evening free and Gathering Night to share insights and to connect with the Portal with Marcia Bellö

- Evening Experience | Sounds of Silence Dinner
- Includes a 3-course gourmet, drinks, and an engaging Star Talk
- Let's witness the iconic Uluru in front and the domes of Kata Tjuta behind, creating a backdrop for a
 breathtaking sunset experience. After dinner, we are going to immerse in world-class stargazing with
 a local star talker guiding us through the Southern night sky. Concluding the evening returning to our
 accommodation at Ayers Rock Resort.

DAY 08 | Friday, 21 June 2024

- From 4:30am Kata Tjuta Sunrise
- We are going to activate the Sacred Portal of Kara Tjuta, understating the history behind these
 ancestral domes with guided meditation and activation at the Portal.
- · Breakfast Included
- From afternoon Uluru Sunset
- One of the most significant monoliths in Australia we are going to visit rick art sites, Anangu (local Aboriginal people), and experience the Mala Walk around the area. An activation and meditation connected with Uluru Sacred Portal.



From 14 to 26 of June 2024

- DAY 09 | Friday, 22 June 2024
 - 7am Morning Meditation and preparation for the day
 - · From 9 am
 - Maruku Arts Tourism Morning Dot Painting Workshop
 - Includes: Aboriginal (Anangu) Artist, Workshop Host, canvas and paints, symbol sheet.
 - We are going to join Maruku's local Anangu artists for a fun introduction to the unique desert art form - Dot Painting in a 1.5-hour format. Learning about the symbols and painting styles used to create beautiful works of art depicting the Creation time (Tjukurpa) stories.
 - Bringing a touch of something unexpected, and colorful and a connection to the experience while celebrating and combining stories of people and places.
 - After Lunch: Private Patji Aboriginal Cultural Tour
 - We are going to join the Traditional Uluru Family in their homelands and experience their culture and family history. Hear from the Traditional Owners themselves on how Paddy Uluru fought for Aboriginal land rights to where Uluru is today.
 - We make our way south of Uluru to the homelands of the Uluru traditional owners, making various stops along the way to hear and experience how life once was and where it is today.
 - We are going to visit the area where the original Uluru Kata Tjuta National Park gates once were, rock water holes, and the ever-changing desert environments.
 - An afternoon tea chatting around the fireplace with our Aboriginal guide. Travel on remote bush tracks take in some spectacular views of Uluru, Kata Tjuta, and the desert landscape. Finishing our afternoon off with sunset on a private sand dune overlooking Uluru and Kata Tjuta.

Can I choose not to participate in certain parts of the Expedition?

<u>The Expedition fee remains unchanged regardless</u> of whether you choose to participate in all segments of the itinerary. It's important to note that there is an interconnected structure throughout the itinerary, involving the confirmation of hotels, guides, training/classes, and other essential elements of the Expedition.

Do I need prior knowledge about portals or the subject studied during the Expedition?

No. Come with an open heart, as our entire itinerary is designed to inspire and bring the wisdom of Aboriginal culture into your life in a profound and memorable way.

How will the activities in national parks and nature be? Do I need physical preparation?

No. The entire itinerary has been designed for the group to experience the locations without extreme activities. If you choose to incorporate some walks into your routine leading up to the trip, it will be a plus for your connection.

Refund and Cancellation Policy

The registration fee of (AUD\$ 800-1200) can be refunded in full until March 31, 2024. After this date, there will be no refund.

Requests for a 100% refund for the remaining amount (AUD\$ 8000.00) will be processed within 30 days of payment. Registrations made after May 1st are eligible for a refund with an advance request until May 19, 2024.
